Eva Cox is a Professorial Fellow at Jumbunna Indigenous House of Learning at the University of Technology.

She is a writer, feminist, sociologist, social commentator and activist for creating more civil societies. Her feminism is all about working towards a better society, not making women more like men. Her ABC [Boyer Lectures](#) in 1995, entitled *A Truly Civil Society* argued that social capital is more important than financial capital. She wants social policies that recognise the value of feelings, relationships, culture and those areas important to both Indigenous people and women.
